

At the General Meeting tonight, October 23rd, the month preceding the Annual Meeting, the floor shall be open, allowing any person to be nominated from the floor as a candidate for a board director position. The nominee for a board director position must be a current member of SCA at the time of nomination and meet the same qualifications as a member of the Board of Directors.

SCA shall not accept payments to qualify for candidacy at the General Meeting of the nomination. If a nominee is found not to meet the qualifications as set forth by the bylaws of the Corporation, that said candidate shall be removed as a candidate for consideration.
